Did You Know?

- It is your right to understand what Family STAR PASS (Parent Access Supervision Services) is all about.
- We offer fully-supervised visits (where the Supervisor will be present the ENTIRE time) and semi-supervised visits (where the Supervisor will be present SOME of the time).
- O Your visit will be in a bright, cheerful and comfortable meeting room.
- It is your right to understand what supervised visitation is all about.
- It is your right to ask questions. If there is something you do not understand, we can help explain it.
- It is your right to tell the Supervisor if you are not comfortable.
- You will have a meeting with us to learn more about what the visits will be like.
- You can bring food, toys, or homework to the visits.
- You can tell us what you would like to do during the visits.
- We want you to feel comfortable and positive about each visit.
- You did not do anything to cause these visits.

Rules for Parents:

- The parent visiting you will have very strict rules to follow.
- If they do not follow the rules, they will be reminded that they must follow them.
- If they do not follow the rules, they will not be able to participate in future visits.



Why Are Visits with My Parent Being Supervised?

Sometimes supervised visits are required if your family has experienced any of the following:

- If you've experienced fighting, yelling or hitting.
- If you haven't seen each other in a very long time
- If a parent is struggling with an illness or addiction.
- If there has been a history of abuse.
- If you are not living with your parents or siblings.
- If your parents are going through a separation or divorce.
- If a court recommends this is best for lots of reasons.

Supervised visits give families an opportunity to reconnect with each other with the support from an outside person. Supervised visits are not a punishment or a bad thing.
